Partnerships in Action

The Bayou District Foundation (BDF) and the Fore!Kids Foundation are celebrating 10 years of partnership in 2016. Fore!Kids Foundation was the initial funder of the Bayou District Foundation. Those monies have been leveraged and sustained over the years resulting in the construction of 685 LEED certified mixed income housing units at the award winning Columbia Parc at the Bayou District. The Educare of New Orleans school was added to the Columbia Parc campus as the beginning of BDF's innovative 'cradle to college' education pipeline in 2013.

Fore!Kids Foundation has been a multiyear supporter of Educare and its groundbreaking work for children 0-5 years old. In recent months, McDonogh 35 Senior High School has opened proximate to Columbia Parc and plans are in place to construct a permanent community health clinic, a K-8 charter school and a neighborhood grocery and pharmacy by 2018.

Bayou District Foundation has hosted over 60 U.S. cities and 6 foreign nations at Columbia Parc and has emerged as a national example of the place based redevelopment model first instituted by Tom Cousins and the East Lake Foundation in Atlanta GA. The BDF and Fore!Kids Foundation partnership is the embodiment of the PGA TOUR Charitable motto "Together, Anything Is Possible."
